The Merry Widows will be meeting at Laredo's Mexican Restaurant here in Seabrook at 6:30.



Lamplight - Opposites Attract

If you love those feel good stories that bring tears to your eyes... have I got a story for you!

It's a delightful story about the unlikely bond between two strangers; a 4-year-old girl and an 82-year-old widower.

When I first read the story on Yahoo News, I thought it was cute, but about a week later, when I saw Steve Hartman's interview on CBS Morning News, it made me cry.

Dan Peterson, the 82-year-old widower, spoke about events that led up to the special encounter at the grocery store. After his wife's death, he had fallen into a deep depression. He began to feel as if he had no purpose, and most of his days were spent watching squirrels scamper around his backyard as he waited to die. Then, along came Norah...

Mr. Peterson hated grocery shopping, and it showed all over his face when he passed by Norah on the canned food aisle. It was Norah's fourth birthday. She wasn't fazed by his grumpiness at all and cheerfully greeted him, saying, "Hi, old person."

Mr. Peterson stopped in his tracks. "Old person?"

Without hesitation Norah responded, "Yes, old person. Can I have a birthday hug?"

Mr. Peterson found himself standing at a cross-roads. Should he ignore this little girl or should he give her a hug? He chose the hug.

Steve Hartman's own eyes glistened as he spoke about the special bond that blossomed between Norah and Mr. Peterson. When asked, "Why do you think all of this happened?" Mr. Peterson answered, "Quite frankly, it was God."

So there it is... God set the agenda for Mr. Peterson that day. Now, Norah and her mom stop by every week to visit Mr. Peterson. She shows up with library books, giggles, and plenty of hugs.

Mr. Peterson has found purpose in the future of a 4-year-old stranger.

This reminds me of God's promise in Jeremiah 29:11 (the Message):

I know what I'm doing. I have it all planned out—plans to take care of you, not abandon you, plans to give you the future you hope for...

May we all remember where our hope comes from... "Quite frankly, it comes from God."
