A friend recently posed the following question on Facebook: What is the purpose of the church? The conversation that ensued was very interesting and challenged my thoughts on the subject.

Acts 2:40-42

⁴⁰And with many other words he testified and exhorted them, saying, "Be saved from this perverse generation." ⁴¹Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were

added to them. ⁴²And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers.

I believe the above scripture to be an excellent outline of the purpose of the church. In fact, I see this passage as an excellent way for us to examine ourselves, both as a church and as individuals.

"Continued steadfastly in the apostle's doctrine" speaks directly to the discipleship of the church. Are we making disciples? Are we teaching well from the pulpit, in Sunday School and in our small groups? I believe for the most part we are doing well in this area. Certainly, there is always room for improvement but this is not our weakest area of ministry.

"Fellowship" is mentioned next in verse 42. We excel at Fellowship. In fact, I think sometimes our skill at Fellowship interferes with the other purposes of the church! Our next special time of Fellowship is the annual Valentine's Day banquet. This event is always very well put together with awesome food catered by El Toro's and home grown entertainment! Sign-up is available on the bulletin board in the hallway of the main building.

"In the breaking of bread" appears next. I don't interpret this to mean just eating (we're good at that, too!) but rather, the Lord's Supper. This brings to mind the celebration of the two ordinances of the church (and aligns with the rest of the scripture in this passage.) I'm challenged about the authenticity surrounding our Lord Supper services. I'm praying about ways for us to better prepare and participate in both the Lord's Supper and Baptisms.

"And in prayers." Fellowship is our strongest point, continuing in the apostle's doctrine is our next strongest point and then the breaking of bread. That means that prayer is our weakest point. Does that sentence hurt your heart like it hurts mine? Prayer is our weakest point. We are one of the few remaining churches with a Wednesday night prayer meeting. Prayer should be our strongest point! When I study the history of the church, when I read of all the folks who gave their lives for the gospel, when I learn of the all the sacrifices being made to just be able to meet as a church and then look at our prayer life, I wonder what God thinks. I wonder what our community thinks. Prayer should be our strongest point. I'll be at the prayer meeting Wednesday night at 6:30. Please come.

The Acts passage ends this way: ⁴³Then fear came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles. ⁴⁴Now all who believed were together, and had all things in common, ⁴⁵and sold their possessions and goods, and divided them among all, as anyone had need. ⁴⁶So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart, ⁴⁷praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.

R.E.F.U.G.E. Student Ministry (6th through 12th grade)


R.E.F.U.G.E. Student Ministry Sunday School meets every Sunday, **9:15—10:30** am in the #1 portable building directly behind the main church building.


Ladies Lunch Bunch All ladies of the church are invited!



February 2017 Lamplight ~ Indefinable Love

Can you believe that it's already the second month of the year? What happened to January?

Ah, February... we only have 334 shopping days left before Christmas; however, before we turn our sights towards blinking lights... let's pause at the halfway point of February – Valentine's Day.

Last year, the National Retailers Federation reported that 54.8% of all Americans would spend an estimated \$19.7 billion on Valentine's Day gifts. Wow, that is a lot of sparkly blings, flowers and sweet nothings!

Since the love month is on the horizon, I decided to take a look at one of the most familiar verses in the Bible --

Οὕτως γὰρ ἠγάπησεν ὁ θεὸς τὸν κόσμον, ὥστε τὸν υἱὸν τὸν μονογενῆ ἔδωκεν, ἵνα πᾶς ὁ πιστεύων εἰς αὐτὸν μὴ ἀπόληται ἀλλ' ἔχη ζωὴν αἰώνιον.

I know, I know... it's all Greek to you, but maybe you will recognize it in English:

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life."

I bet you recognize it now! And here is another fun-fact...if you read a red-letter Bible, you also know that Jesus spoke these words.

The Greek word for "loved," ἠγάπησεν (ay.ga.pay.sen) is a verb—Aorist, Active, Indicative, Third Person, Singular— meaning "he loved." The Aorist form in the Greek language is "past" tense in form, but does not define or limit duration.

Most of us are familiar with the Greek word "agape." This word means love, and on many occasions we have been taught that it refers to God's *unconditional love*. Even though most Greek Lexicons do not reflect "unconditional" as part of the parsing, we do find that "agape" indicates a "higher" form of love. Agape is the only lexical form associated with God and God's love.

1 John 4:8 - θεὸς ἀγάπη - God is love.

Romans 8:38-39: τῆς ἀγάπης τοῦ θεοῦ τῆς ἐν Χριστῶ Ἰησοῦ τῶ κυρίω ἡμῶν

For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

One more thought... We also find several forms of "agape" in John 13:34-35 where Jesus commands us to love one another:

έντολὴν καινὴν δίδωμι ὑμῖν, ἵνα <mark>ἀγαπᾶτε</mark> ἀλλήλους, καθὼς <mark>ἠγάπησα</mark> ὑμᾶς ἵνα καὶ ὑμεῖς <mark>ἀγαπᾶτε</mark> ἀλλήλους. ἐν τούτῳ γνώσονται πάντες ὅτι ἐμοὶ μαθηταί ἐστε, ἐὰν <mark>ἀγάπην</mark> ἔχητε ἐν ἀλλήλοις.

A new commandment I give to you, that you **love** one another: just as I have **loved** you, you also are to **love** one another. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have **love** for one another."

In this passage we find two "Present-Active-Subjunctive" verbs, one "Aorist-Active-Indicative" verb, and one "Accusative" noun...

You may wonder why this is significant. Well, it clarifies something very important to all of us...

During this day and age when love seems to have grown cold, temporal human love doesn't accomplish much. For this reason we must rely on God's supernatural ability to love through us. Then, with His help we can actively love one another with His "indefinable, indescribable" love.

Remember this... not only did you learn a bunch of Greek today, but you are *loved* and you are always in my prayers.
